reduction in daily maximum demand. Improving the electrical efficiency of the site as predicted.

POWERPERFECTOR EXHIBITS AT THE TATE GALLERY



The Tate storage facility holds approximately 95% of the assets of the Tate Gallery, worth billions of pounds. As a critical site it has a sophisticated climate controlled environment to protect our national treasures. The focus on protection and best practice is evident in gaining access to the site and we were pleased to add extra security to the supply and site, along with the benefits of energy and cost saving with the installation of a 210kVA

powerPerfector unit 24th July 2006. This has resulted in a reduction in average kWh consumption of over 12.9%. Those disappointed that we are not an actual exhibit can come and see a pP unit at NEMEX.

Installing the powerPerfector has the additional benefit of protecting against transients and of suppressing harmonics, crucial advantages when large amounts of data are stored.
