MUSEUMS SAVING MORE THAN OUR HERITAGE



John Bull, Head of Estates North for the National Museum of Science and Industry.

"The National Railway Museum, founded in 1975 houses its collection of objects in 3 main halls with two ancillary buildings on the same site. Originally our main buildings were the York goods terminal, bonded warehouse and maintenance shed.

Electricity consumption has been rising

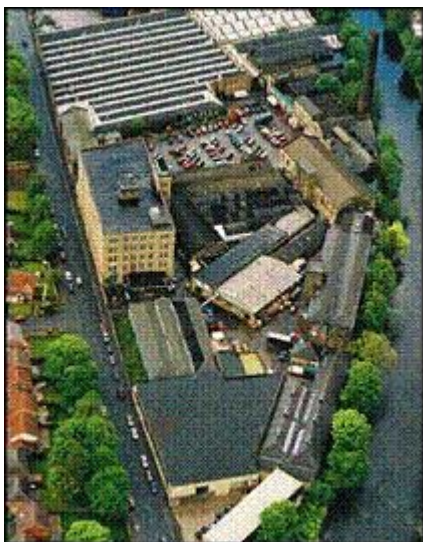
steadily as new displays demand more dramatic lighting, interactives and audio-visual equipment. In addition, there are increasing demands for improved environmental storage for objects not on display. The result was a 25% increase in electricity consumption over 2 years.

As part of the NRM's drive to reduce it's energy consumption, Voltage Power Optimization was evaluated and we decided to go ahead., and ordered a pP740kVa with a 9% optimisation and estimated savings forecast of 14% - a 19 month pay-back. In fact, we installed two units - a second one at our sister museum, the National Media Museum in Bradford.

The installation went absolutely according to plan. The NRM is open 362 days a year, so all the work had to be done out of hours and without any impact on our visitors. The unit has now been in operation for 6 months and is achieving the savings we counted on. We can see the steady upward trend in our electricity consumption has started to turn downwards.

PowerPerfector have been professional through and through. The installation went as planned, the savings they calculated are being delivered. All in all, an extremely successful project."

Namely, the very import difference between Fixed and Variable. powerPerfector falls into the Fixed category - the technology is installed, your savings are established and fixed year on year, you fit and forget. Variable technology requires monitoring by a team that understands the energy efficiency programme, it can be susceptible to inconsistent maintenance which if un-monitored can effect the savings performance. Under funding in this area can undo all the good that the technology provided when first commissioned.
