The lifeline for businesses is £100m of interest-free loans which is available through the Carbon Trust, for equipment costing £3,000 - £400,000." source Carbon Trust.

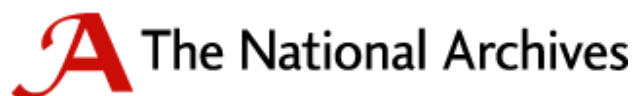
Along with Salix Finance (see below) there are now considerable funds available to assist your business in wiping out unnecessary energy waste.

JONATHAN PORRITT AT LONDON GREEN500



On 9th September Green 500 and the Better Buildings Partnership brought together London's most prominent owners and occupiers to develop sustainability solutions to the commercial property market.

With the built environment contributing between 40-50% of the UK's total emissions, the urgent need to address this has finally been met by the government with a range of carrots and sticks including the CRC (carbon reduction commitment) and DEC (display energy certificate). One of the key agreements was that although new build is where most of the innovation is taking place, viable solutions must be made available for existing buildings, as they make up the majority of the built environment and tend to be the least efficient.

The keynote speaker, JONATHAN PORRITT, made mention of a single technology that could meet the needs of both the landowner and the current climate consensus. I quote:

"I had an interesting example the other day where I went to visit a small company marketing something called powerPerfactor which is essentially a voltage optimisation technology. [It] can be made to work for any organisation with large electricity bills and this is a relatively simple system, it's not particularly complicated to install, the savings are substantial on both total energy consumption and the carbon footprint. You look at that and you say - why would anyone not want to make an investment with such a quick payback period to ratchet down their consumption and CO2 emissions."

Jonathan Porritt, Founder of Forum for the Future and heads the Sustainable Development Commission.

This is the foundation of energy efficiency strategy, one that is great for business and the environment that allows for real change to be made right now when it's needed.

Green 500 is the London Mayor's initiative to target the 500 largest organisations in London with the greatest potential for carbon reduction with the aim of setting up a global standard of environmental excellence,
